



COVID-19 - GUIDELINES

Students on Campus are required to:

- Be subjected to body temperature checks anytime they enter the Rome Center;
- Wear a facemask at all times in all outdoor and indoor spaces of the Rome Center;
- Maintain a physical distance of at least one (1) meter (3 feet) from others at all times;
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water or use hand sanitizers;
- Ventilate rooms on a regular basis and leave windows open as much as possible;
- Follow the general rules of hygiene in each common space (i.e., library, dining hall, lobby, laundry, computer lab, Chapel, ect.);
- Be reachable by phone (or WhatsApp, etc.) and check email daily;
- Not share linens and towels, and wash them regularly;
- Rome Center staff will provide all the information of any variations of governmental regulations regarding restrictions on covid
- Students must follow Italian regulations and measures for COVID safety, the Rome Center Staff is not responsible for any consequences deriving from the non-compliance with the laws in force or the non-compliance with the prohibitions provided by the Italian law
 - No guests are allowed in the Center

In addition to the measures listed above, students in quarantine must:

- NOT LEAVE the Rome Center for the entire quarantine period;
- Stay in isolation for fourteen (14) days from the day of arrival.

As an additional measure to keep our Center safe, we have added COVID-19 screening tests: all the Rome Center Community (students, faculty, staff, and security guards) will be tested once a week.

Please remember that any student experiencing flu-like symptoms, has tested COVID-positive, or has been in close contact with a COVID-positive person should immediately notify the Rome Center staff.

COVID-19 – GUIDELINES for Faculty

Faculty on Campus are asked to:

- Be subjected to body temperature checks anytime they enter the Rome Center;
- Wear a facemask at all times in all outdoor and indoor spaces of the Rome Center;
- Maintain a physical distance of at least one (1) meter (3 feet) from others at all times;
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water or use hand sanitizers;
- Ventilate the classrooms on a regular basis and leave windows open at the end of each class;
- Follow the general rules of hygiene in each common space (i.e., library, dining hall, lobby, laundry, computer lab, Chapel, ect.);
- Sanitize their desks, their computers and all the items used in the classroom before and at the end of each class;
- Rome Center staff will provide all the information of any variations of governmental regulations regarding restrictions on covid
- Faculty and visiting faculty must follow Italian regulations and measures for COVID safety, the Rome Center Staff is not responsible for any consequences deriving from the non-compliance with the laws in force or the non-compliance with the prohibitions provided by the Italian law
- No guests are allowed in the Center

As an additional measure to keep our Center safe, we have added COVID-19 screening tests: all the Rome Center Community (students, faculty, staff, and security guards) will be tested once a week.

Please remember that any faculty experiencing flu-like symptoms, has tested COVID-positive, or has been in close contact with a COVID-positive person should immediately notify the Rome Center staff.
